John More is a Washington, DC-based lawyer and community activist. He serves as the treasurer and a director of a number of non-profits for which he also provides legal advice in their formation, corporate governance, and filings for 501(c)(3) tax status.

In the Internet area, John is currently the Treasurer of the Washington DC Chapter of the Internet Society and the Chapter's Delegate to the Chapters Advisory Council. He has been involved with the Chapter since the early 2000s, more recently serving as one of the Co-Chairs. For the Internet Society and a number of other international organizations involved with the Internet, he has provided legal advice on corporate governance and assisted in drafting their governing and procedural documents.

Since the DC Chapter serves as the Secretariat for the IGF USA, John has been very active in the annual IGF USA event, including providing treasurer services.

In the District of Columbia, John has been active in affordable housing and neighborhood redevelopment through multi-racial interfaith grassroots organizing group, Washington Interfaith Network ("WIN"). He also has served for more than 20 years with the Rachel Carson Council, Inc., an environmental justice activist group, as a director.

John has a PhD in Classical Philology from Harvard University (and taught Classics for seven years) and a JD from Harvard Law School. He is fluent or knowledgeable in a number of languages.
